Important Information

Bookings

All booking for Vacation Care are made through "Fully Booked".

By booking your child/children into programmed Vacation Care days via "Fully Booked" you are giving permission for your child/children to participate in all activities on In Days and Excursion's including being transported to and from locations using chartered buses, which are all fitted with regulation seatbelts.

Vacation Care bookings will close **Friday 19th September** and online permission forms sent out on Monday 30th June, to ensure staffing and bus transportation numbers can be finalised.

Transportation

Written permission is still required for bus transportation, this will be sent online after bookings close through the schools Edsmart Portal.

Please contact us to complete a hard copy version, if you don't want it sent through Edsmart. The form can be returned to the OSHC office or electronically to oshc.clgps629@schools.sa.edu.au.

Risk assessments are prepared for each in day and excursion and are available at Colonel Light Gardens OSHC in hard copy form and digitally on our Toddle page. Written policies and procedures for transporting children are available to read at CLG OSHC.

Cancellations

- In days need to be cancelled with **48 hours' notice before the session starts** to not be charged the full fee.
- For excursions a fee of \$20 per day/per session will apply to excursion cancellations within 2 weeks of the session starting.

Excursions

You are aware that children must be at Vacation care by **8.30am** on excursion days. This is to allow for staff to go through excursion expectations, routine checks and headcounts onto buses. Excursions are programmed for varying times, **please ensure** you check each individual day in the program.

We ensure that headcounts occur regularly to monitor number of children on excursions. Therefore, daily attendance sheets and emergency contact details in hard copy form are taken when off school site. All medications and medical plans for individual children including epi-pens and asthma puffers as well as first aid kits and mobile phones are also taken with us.

Ratio

CLG OSHC is licensed for up to 154 children daily. Staff to child ratios are regulated at 1:8 when on excursions, 1:5 on excursions involving water and on school site ratios are 1:15.

Health/Medical

If your child/ren require medication (epi, asthma, allergy, restricted medication, etc) please make sure you have updated your enrolment forms to reflect this. Remember to update all your child/ren's medical documentation and provide a copy to CLG OSHC. We can not administer medication without proper documentation.

→ This includes: Ritalin, Panadol, Nurofen, Antihistamine, etc.

All medications and medical plans for individual children including epi-pens/asthma puffers as well as first aid kits are kept on site for In Days and taken along on excursion.

CLG OSHC is a nut aware and sesame aware environment.

Please do not supply lunches or snacks consisting of Peanut Butter, Nutella or other nut products.

Clothing Requirements

All children need to wear appropriate casual SunSmart clothing with shoulders and torso covered (no singlet, crop, tank tops, etc.)

Shoes: Please make sure your child/ren wear comfortable walking shoes (no thongs, crocs, slides, etc.) which are appropriate for active games/sports.

Hats: SunSmart hats (broadbrimmed, bucket, legionnaires) must be worn every day when the UV is 3 or above.

Any child who is not dressed appropriately will miss out on certain activities.

Valuables

No spending money unless stipulated otherwise.

Please leave valuable items/toys at home as they may get lost or broken.

OSHC will take no responsibility for these items.
